



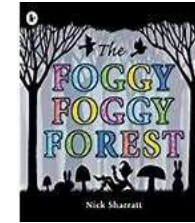
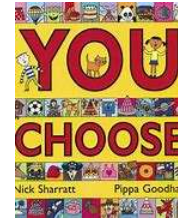
## Vocabulary Dozen

Sorting objects and saying which group has more or less.

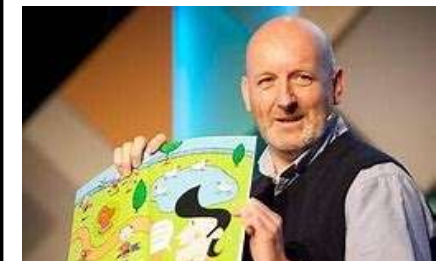
Saying one more and one less than a given number up to 5.
