

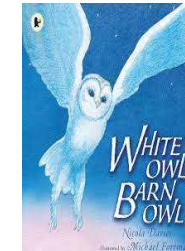
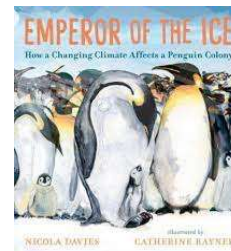
Vocabulary Dozen
