Attendance

Good attendance at school is vitally important. One day missed Can mean a gap in learning that takes weeks to Catch up on. Sadly at Broadmeadow we have far too many children taking unauthorised absences. To help to encourage better attendance we have introduced a reward scheme:

- Each week the class with the best attendance will get extra playtime.
- Each half term the children with 100% attendance or those who have improved their attendance will get to watch a **movie and have popcorn**. They will also get a **certificate** and a ticket to go into a **termly raffle**
- Each term the children will get the certificate, movie and raffle ticket. The raffle will be drawn and the winning ticket will receive a prize of a fo Sainsburys Voucher.

So each term there are 3 opportunities to win a prize and six opportunities for your child to get rewarded for great attendance.

However, the greatest reward for good attendance is progress in learning and building great relationships with their peers.
