Hi Everyone,

Thank you to all of you who responded to the parents who responded to the questionnaire sent home last week. We had 67 responses and some really useful feedback which we will use to prioritise and inform the areas that we look to improve further.

Some real positives were:

- 97% said that their children were happy at school.
- 94% said that their child felt safe at school.
- 96% said that the school is a welcoming place to visit.

Although there have been great improvements in many areas since the Ofsted Inspection Survey, we are continuing to look at ways to improve the areas that you identified could be better.

This term we are really focusing our attention on phonics and reading. Any reading that you can do with your child always helps them develop a vital life skill which opens the door to learning and a broad and balanced curriculum.
