Since my last newsletter we have had Little Wandle come into school to see how we teach phonics, they were very pleased with what they saw and said the teachers were doing a great job!

We have started to change how we teach reading. Next week the teachers will have some training and the following week the new reading sessions will start.

We have introduced a new system for tracking each child's progress, this will track their progress from Nursery all the way to Year 2. Using this system, we will be able to tell how much progress they make in reading, writing and maths each term and if there are any gaps, or areas that they need more help with. We have joined with the junior school to introduce a new computing and handwriting scheme, both will start in September.

Today I had the pleasure of leading our celebration assembly, congratulations to the children chosen and thank you parents for attending.
