Dear Parents/carers,

**Spellings and Phonics for next week**

**Reception:**

Reception would like the children to practice words that contain the following sounds: 'ai' 'ee' 'igh' and 'oa'

**Year 1:**

Will be learning to read and spell words that include a split digraph. A split digraph is where one sound splits the vowels e.g. **stage** has a split digraph but not **change**. They are also learning to read and spell the words: eye, thought, through, because, once and friend

**Year 2:**

Year 2 teachers would like the children to practice spelling words that end in 'tion' or 'sion' for example:

Motion, station, potion, television, ation, mission, division, portion, lotion, invasion
